

## Description

The protruding lower section with a pierced spindle front and a central door below an upper section with two doors flanked by carved uprights.

A Victorian interpretation of a 17th century glass cabinet. The lower section originally used for housing drinking glasses - the open spindles protecting what were then considered precious objects, while being able to show off the owner's collection.
