Description

The upholstered drop in seat inset into a solid walnut frame with four tapered and faceted legs, typical of Birkett's work, joined by champhered stretchers.

Hugh Birkett (1919 - 2002) was an important proponent of the craft revival in England and created largely private commissions from his workshop in Moreton-in-Marsh, embracing the ethics and practices of the Cotswold School which was such an inspiration on his work.
