Description

Comprising overlaid orange feathers, each attached to a reed. These were worn along with elephant masks at tribal funeral ceremonies.

The Bamileke make up the largest ethnic group in Cameroon, comprising several tribal chiefdoms. They are known for their elephant dance masks, which are worn for special events.
